Summer Rehearsals and Events

Band Camp: (Includes Percussion and Color Guard)

We are excited to welcome students back to band camp this year! This weeklong event provides an opportunity for your child to get a head start on the music and marching routines they will be learning for the upcoming marching season.

During the camp your student will have an opportunity, each day, to work in small groups with professional instructors specific to their instrument, learn the marching routine with help from experienced marching coaches, and practice the music they will play during the field show competitions. In addition to the music instruction, summer camp presents an opportunity for your student to meet and bond with the other marching band students; this is especially helpful for incoming freshmen and other new students to the program.

Band camp attendance is strongly encouraged, as we will be learning drill. If you will not be present for camp, please notify me as soon as possible. Students who miss camp will typically begin the year as an alternate.

Percussion Rehearsals and Camp



For the fall season, our percussion students begin rehearsing in June.

In the percussion section, students have the choice to play one of multiple instruments. This is a very different environment than other wind sections, as your child will have a choice to play a different instrument each year. For this reason, we hold rehearsals throughout the summer to acclimate students to marching percussion. This also gives our new members a chance to meet percussion staff and become acquainted with the marching instruments before school ends, and to begin learning the music for

our fall show. Your child may be interested in playing in the battery section, or may be a part of the front ensemble.

We encourage students to attend all rehearsals if they are in town. For any student interested in marching in the battery, all June rehearsals are very important. At the first rehearsal, students will be asked to provide contact information for best reaching both students and parents. Students will also be provided with contact information for staff in case they will miss any summer rehearsals. Please contact either a staff member or myself if you will miss any rehearsals. The battery line and front ensemble will be set early in the summer, so attending rehearsals is very important.

We will also be holding a week long percussion training camp, from July 11th to July 15th. Please see the schedule below for a complete list of dates:

Rancho Bernardo 4th of July Parade Info: Tentative Schedule

All Color Guard, Percussion battery and **10th-12th** grade band members will participate in Rancho Bernardo's Fourth of July Parade on July 4th. The expectation is that if you are going to be in the music and guard program next year, and you are in town, you are expected to participate in the parade. You must attend the rehearsal <u>AND</u> the parade. More information, including updated call times, will be sent closer to the event.

New band members (apart from percussion and guard) will not march in the parade, but are invited to watch and cheer on their fellow band members.

Rehearsal will take place on Wednesday, July 29th from 4:00 to 6:00 PM at MCHS.

Monday, July 4th the parade call time is tentatively scheduled for 2:45 PM. We will meet in the shopping center parking lot on the corner of Lomica and Acena, and you can find MC in front of the Post Office. The Parade is set to begin at 3:30 PM. We should finish the route no later than 4:45 PM.

Students will wear their summer uniform, which is listed below. Information on how to order polo shirts and jerseys will be sent out by our music foundation later this summer.

Marching Band, Percussion, and Guard: Fall Information

As mentioned, our fall season can begin quite suddenly! Below are some important dates to be aware of, as well as some general reminders regarding the upcoming fall season. Please makes sure to always check our program's website, your email, as well as the calendar to receive the most updated information.

Fall Rehearsals:

Marching Band (Guard, Brass, Wind, and Percussion) rehearse every Wednesday evening, from 6:00 to 9:15 in the Sundevil Stadium, beginning on August 17th and ending on November 16th.

Percussion rehearse on Monday evening, from 6:30 to 8:30 PM.

Color Guard rehearses on Monday evening, from 5:30 to 9:00 PM.

There will also be occasional Saturday rehearsals, which will be listed on our band calendar. Marching Band tournaments will take place on Saturday evenings, typically between 6 and 9:00 PM. Parade Band reviews will also take place on Saturdays, but during the morning and afternoon hours. Parade Band dates will be added to the calendar once scheduled.

Below are a list of important dates to be aware of. Please remember that our calendar is subject to change, so make sure to check it often. Any scheduling changes will also be communicated directly to students and from our foundation.
