Director's Information

Arrival/Check In:

Directors will receive a packet with lanyards or passes for staff, the assigned number of wristbands for chaperones and equipment crews, and pertinent information for the tournament. Please gauge your arrival time to meet the needs of unloading, dressing and warming-up in preparation for your performance.

Upon your arrival, we will hand stamp all students. No adults will be hand stamped. We will issue 1 chaperone wristband for every 10 performers. For example, if you have 60 performers, then you will receive 6 chaperone wristbands. We will follow the same formula for your equipment crew, so a band with 60 performers will receive 6 chaperone and 6 equipment crew wristbands. Student hand stamps, chaperone, and equipment crew wristbands will allow entrance to the stadium during the tournament.

During your performance chaperone and equipment crew should sit on the benches at the edge of the home side field. They will not be allowed in the home side stands. If parents wish to enter the home side of the stadium they will be required to purchase a ticket. We will be providing 1 to 2 guides per group depending on your group size. These students will be there to assist you in any way possible.

Admission:

The admission price for the tournament is \$15 for adults, \$10 for Seniors, Active Duty Military with ID and Students with ID. Children 10 and under are FREE.

Announcer:

Pre and post show announcements will be made by the announcer.

Concessions Stand:

A variety of foods and beverages will be available for sale to your students, chaperones and parents. Absolutely no ice chests, food, or drinks may be brought into either side of the stadium. RBVHS campus policy prohibits cooking/food preparation in the parking lots. This is a fundraiser event and we encourage ALL participants to support the Rancho Buena Vista Band & Color Guard by purchasing food at the concession stands in the stadium.

Programs:

Programs will be provided free of charge by scanning the QR code at the entrances, snack bar, and bleacher entrance.

Video Taping/Photography:

No video service will be provided at the tournament. Each band may videotape its own performance. However, no wristbands will be given to your band for a photographer/videographer. No taping will be allowed from the top of the press box.

Seating Chart: Your assigned seating chart will be included in your packet at Director Check-In on the day of the event.

<u>Bus/Truck Parking Passes</u>: Due to parking limitations, parking assignments will be given to you at BUS CHECK IN on the day of the event. We will reserve space for your buses, support vehicles, and two director vehicles.

Director/Staff Parking:

Will be available in the Staff parking lot at the front of the school. We have a list of all staff for our parking attendant. Anyone not on the list will have to park in Patron Parking. If the Staff Lot is full there is free street parking.

Patron Parking:

We will also have a limited number of paid parking spots at the school for \$10/car. These will be available on a first come, first served basis. Free parking is available along the east side of Longhorn Drive, along Melrose Drive and Shadowridge Drive where posted, in the sports field parking lot on Shadowridge Drive, and in the parking lot at the corner of Melrose Drive & Shadowridge Drive.

Percussion Equipment:

Please make sure that you have adequate staff and or "pit crew" to assist moving your percussion equipment to and from the performance area. Please call Eric Weirather at (760) 535-3218 if you are in need of any help. We ask that all pit sections arrive at least ONE band prior to your group's scheduled performance time. PLEASE REMEMBER: WHEN MOVING YOUR EQUIPMENT, NO TRUCKS OF ANY SIZE OR WEIGHT WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK DURING THIS EVENT.

Adjudication Forms:

We will be using the SCSBOA "Caption Sheets".

Awards Ceremony:

Please send your leaders to the fifty-yard line on the visitor's side immediately after the last band's performance. Awards will be presented for band, auxiliary, and overall percussion in 1st up to 4th places, depending upon the number of bands entered in the division. Sweepstakes in Percussion, Auxiliary, Visual Sweepstakes (combined General Effect Visual and Visual Performance) and Music Sweepstakes (combined General Effect Music and Music Performance) will be awarded, as well as a Grand Champion trophy.

Warm-Up:

All bands will receive warm up times and maps in Director Packet at Check In. WE ASK THAT YOUR PERFORMANCE GROUP BE READY AT THE GATE 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO YOUR PERFORMANCE TIME. ANY UNIT IN THE STAGING AREA OR ANY OTHER AREA OTHER THAN THE WARM UP AREA, WHICH INTERFERES WITH A COMPETING UNIT DURING THEIR PERFORMANCE, MAY BE GIVEN A 1.0 PENALTY OFF THE BAND SHEET. THIS PENALTY MAY BE GIVEN AFTER THE FIRST WARNING AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT WARNING. ALL PARKING LOTS ARE SILENT AREAS.

Changing Area:

All uniform changing must be done in your vehicles or in various changing areas that you may have brought with you. There will be no locker rooms available for changing.

Hospitality Tent:

There will be a section on the west end of the stadium for band directors and staff personnel with the proper lanyard. Please advise your organization that this is a private area for band directors and staff only.

Directions to Rancho Buena Vista High School and Parking Map

From Interstate 5:

- Take Hwy 78 East about 5.5 miles to S. Melrose Dr.
- Turn right on S. Melrose Dr. and go about 2 miles to Shadowridge Dr.
- Turn right on Shadowridge Dr. and right on Longhorn Dr.

From Interstate 15:

- Take Hwy 78 West about 7 miles to Sycamore Ave.
- Turn left on Sycamore Ave. and right on Shadowridge Dr.
- Take Shadowridge Dr. about 2.2 miles and turn right on Longhorn Dr.

Note: The large parking lot is primarily reserved for buses, equipment trucks, and directors. Paid parking is available for \$10. Spectator parking is available along marked areas of Melrose Dr. Shadowridge Dr. and Longhorn Dr. See map for more information.
